#### Meaning and use

##### Positive

The present perfect is made with **subject + have/has + past participle**.

**I've taught** English in Italy and in Russia.

**Johnny Depp has starred** in lots of brilliant films.

##### Negative

The negative present perfect is made with **subject + have/has not + past participle**.

**I haven't seen the first Bond film.**

**I haven't seen** the first Bond film.

#### Questions

Present perfect yes/no questions are made from **have/has + subject + past participle?**

Present perfect question word questions are made from **question word + have/has + subject + past participle?**

**Darren:** Well what about Larry? We haven't met him yet but his resume looks good. He has been a salesperson in the food industry for 13 years. He has worked in The United States, Canada and Mexico. In the past 4 years he has learned to speak Spanish and French.

**Bob:** Wow, sounds great!

**Darren:** The problem is we still haven't had an interview with him. I have called him many times, but I haven't been able to reach him.

**Bob:** Well, why don't you send him an email? Perhaps he will respond that way.

**Darren:** OK, I will try that. I will let you know.

**Bob:** Great, thanks.
